Registration Notes:

Both the Early Bird and regular Walk Registration receive a t-shirt, just the price is different:

- Early Bird Registration (June 1 July 5): \$15
- ❖ Walk Registration (July 5 September 10, and day of registration): \$20

Only those registered by August 23 can pick up their t-shirts at AVH. Later registrations can pick up their shirt in the morning at the event (requested size not guaranteed, based on availability)

Like last year, we will be reaching out to Team Captains to find out if you want to pick up your entire team's shirts at AVH, or have individuals pick them up themselves.



FUNDRAISING METHOD

We are so thrilled that you have decided to fundraise for the 18th Annual Community Link Buddy Walk[®]. We have pulled together a quick four-step method to assist you in your fundraising.

STEP ONE: PLAN

Before you begin fundraising, we suggest creating a plan for your fundraising efforts. We have included a fundraising timeline to provide you with an idea of good times to push your fundraising efforts throughout the Buddy Walk season. We want you to be successful with your fundraising!

Build your network! Think about a list of people or businesses who might donate to your efforts this year. We recommend starting with:

- Friends and families
- Current or former colleagues and classmates
- Neighbors
- Church/Religious network
- Local businesses your family frequents (restaurants, retail stores, etc.)
- Social media connections

STEP TWO: TELL YOUR STORY

- We encourage you to tell your story. Your child or the individual who inspired you to create a team for Community Link's Buddy Walk® is a great start to your story. The questions below can help you practice your story:
- ❖ Why do you walk in Community Link's Buddy Walk®?
- How has certain programming impacted you and your Buddy?
- How has Down syndrome (or other developmental disability) impacted your life and why do you believe it's important to raise money for Community Link?

We have included a sample fundraising letter on the next page to help you start telling your story. We do encourage you to customize this letter and include a photo of your Buddy.

STEP THREE: REMIND YOUR NETWORK

We understand that reminding your networks about your fundraising can be difficult given how long the Buddy Walk fundraising season is. We suggest using stories of your Buddy to promote your fundraising efforts throughout the year. Sending out notes to remind your network about a milestone your Buddy has reached can also be a great way to solicit for additional donations at different times of the year. The more personal you can make it, the better!

STEP FOUR: THANKING YOUR DONORS

Don't forget to thank all those people who supported your team this year. The Community Link Buddy Walk website makes it easy to download your donor report with addresses, so you can send a quick, but heartfelt thank you note.

FUNDRAISING IDEAS FOR YOUR TEAM

We encourage you to choose some creative ways to fundraise for our team, aside from soliciting donations through letters and social media. Think outside the box! Here are examples of some fun fundraising ideas.

INVOLVE THE COMMUNITY

- ❖ **Birthday Donation:** Ask your friends and family to donate to your fundraiser in honor of your birthday. Facebook makes this extra easy to do.
- ❖ Corporate Matching: This is a simple way to multiply your donations. Some companies will match donations made by their employees. Many do a straight 1:1 to match, but others take it to the next level, offering a 2:1 or 3:1 commitment!
- **Eat for a Cause:** Ask a local restaurant to donate 10% of their profits on a designated day for Community Link's Buddy Walk. Encourage friends and community members to participate.
- Play for a Cause: Ask local businesses (crafting studio, skating rink, indoor children's play center, etc.) to designate a single day as a fundraiser for your Buddy Walk® team and donate all profits, a percentage of profits, or a certain amount to your team.
- Lemonade Stand: Host a good old-fashioned lemonade stand with your kids!
- ❖ Dessert Potluck: Nothing brings folks together like a potluck, and nothing makes folks happier than dessert! Combine the two for a sweet evening of community—literally. Guests pay a suggested donation and bring a dessert (or three) to share.
- ❖ Wine Raffle Pull: This is a perfect idea for a lady's night, and is simple to do. Ask local stores or restaurants to donate bottles of wine. Wrap up the wines to hide their values. Then, sell "wine pull" tickets that allow people to pull a bottle out of the selection of wrapped wines.
- ❖ Sporting Event Watch Party: Build off the passion, energy, and commitment of sports fans for your next fundraising campaign. Reserve a room or host a game viewing party at your home with plenty of snacks and drinks. You can charge a small entry fee and add a capacity limit to your event to control the headcount.
- ❖ Penny Drive or Penny War: Get teams (school classes, sports teams, etc) to compete by collecting the most coins in a set time frame like a month or school term. Have them use empty 5L water bottles for each class/team to collect their coins in. Talk to a local pizza restaurant to see if they would donate pizzas to the winning class/team. You get all the pennies to apply to your fundraiser.
- ❖ Yard/Garage Sale: Clean out the clutter and support your team! Get the word out to friends, neighbors, and supporters that you are hosting a yard/garage sale fundraiser. Ask them to donate items to be sold, and to come shop your sale. Include a donation jar along with information about the Buddy Walk® and your fundraising effort.
- **❖ Twenty-One Dollar Tuesday:** On Tuesday, ask your connections across all your social media accounts to donate \$21 to your fundraiser. Do a shout-out post to recognize those that donate.
- Host a Sales Party: Host a consultant party with a portion of proceeds benefiting your team (i.e. Mary Kay, Pampered Chef, Tupperware) or ask a friend with a business to host one to benefit your fundraiser.



FUNDRAISING IDEAS (continued)

- Benefit Workout Class: Ask your gym to host a benefit workout class where donations can go to your fundraiser.
- ❖ 50/50 Raffle: This is easy to setup and do. You don't need to find or buy prizes. Ask friends and family to donate items that can be auctioned or raffled off either online or at an in-person gathering. Simply sell raffle tickets and split the proceeds50/50 with the winner/s. You get 50% of the sales and the winner gets the other50. (In many cases, the winner will also donate their portion).
- Dress Down for Down Syndrome Day: Ask your employer or your child's school to host a dress down day(s), where employees who donate a certain amount to your fundraiser can wear jeans/comfy clothes.
- ❖ Donation Jar: See if local merchants will let you set up a donation canister near the cash register. Provide a flyer that explains your efforts on behalf of your Buddy Walk® team.
- Get Help Spreading the Word: Request to have your fundraising page link shared on the social media page or newsletter of your church, temple, gym, neighborhood, school, etc.
- ❖ Fundraising Calendars for Social Media: Customize and share the provided calendar template on your social media pages and ask your friends and family to "buy" a date (examples on following page).
- Fundraising Bingo/Scratch-off Cards: Customize and share the provided template cards on your social media pages. Ask your followers to choose a number or amount and donate it (examples on following page).

BOOST OUTREACH

- ❖ Pin: Create a pin that says "ask me about the Buddy Walk" and wear it around town.
- ❖ Social Networks: Post a message on your favorite social media page asking your friends to support your efforts. Be sure to use the hashtag #CommunityLinkBuddyWalk or #CommunityLink
- **Email Signature:** Include your team name in your email signature.
- Share the Passion: Tell your story. The more you talk about your why you're involved in your Walk, the more people will share in that excitement and want to donate or join your team.
- Classmates: Ask your child's teacher if she can send home a Walk flier in his/her classmates' backpacks.
- ❖ Meet the Press: Get an article in your company newsletter. Ask them to publish an article about you in which you request support.
- Bulletin Boards: Post a Buddy Walk postcard on bulletin boards at the gym, community center, coffee shop, etc.

USE YOUR TALENTS

- Baby-sit
- ❖ Pet-sit
- House-sit
- Water the Garden: Or any chores you or a family member would normally do for free for neighbors, friends or family, this time, ask them for a team donation.
- **Computer Graphics:** If you are good with computers, make nice cards and give them for pledges.



DONATION INFORMATION

CAN I ENTER DONATIONS RECEIVED VIA CHECK TO MY WEBPAGE?

WHAT IF PEOPLE WANT TO GIVE ME CASH?

It is safest and best for record-keeping that you convert all cash received to a check or money order. If you are able, the safest option is to send a personal check covering the full amount, along with the corresponding donation forms to Community Link. We will be able to credit your friends and family for their generosity (as long as the forms are clearly completed with all information—name, address and amount given). ARE DONATIONS TAX DEDUCTIBLE?

WHERE DO I GET DONATION AND REGISTRATION FORMS?

- Donation and registration forms are enclosed in this packet. You may also print additional forms from the Team Captain's Corner on Community Link's Buddy Walk® website, or stop by the Breese East or Metro Buildings.
- Use the donation form for people wanting to make a donation only. Individuals wanting to participate in the Walk or 5K need to complete a registration form so they can receive a t-shirt.

WHO SHOULD BUDDY WALK CHECKS BE MADE PAYABLE TO?

- For tax purposes, please make checks payable to Community Link. Checks should not be written to Buddy Walk teams, team captains or individual participants.
- Please ask teammates to submit their corresponding donation tracking forms with their checks so your team will be properly credited for your fundraising efforts. If this is not possible please ask donors to indicate which walk team they are supporting and your name on the memo section of the check.

CORPORATE MATCH FAQs

I THINK MY COMPANY MATCHES, HOW DO I GET THIS STARTED?

Every company handles its own matching gift program differently. FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

WHAT IS THE REGISTRATION FEE?

The early bird registration fee is \$15 per person for the Walk before July 5th. After July 5th, the Walk fee will be \$20 per person. Both registrations include an official commemorative Community Link Buddy Walk® t-shirt. Please register at: COMMLINK.ORG/BUDDYWALK

SHOULD I REGISTER MY KIDS?

Yes, please register everyone who will be attending (even toddlers in strollers). This helps us plan for the day of the event, plus only those who register receive t-shirts.

I HAVE A FAMILY MEMBER WHO WANTS TO JOIN MY TEAM BUT MAY NOT BE ABLE TO ATTEND THE WALK. CAN THEY STILL JOIN MY TEAM?

Yes, family members can still support you by joining your team and fundraise as a team member even if they are unable to attend.

WHAT IS THE CUT-OFF TO JOIN A TEAM?

You can register online until September 10th until 11:59 PM. And, you can register at the event, but we encourage everyone to register before August 23rd to be guaranteed a t-shirt.

SOME OF MY FAMILY WOULD LIKE TO COME, BUT NOT WALK. DO THEY NEED TO REGISTER?

Everyone is welcome to attend. We encourage every participant to register by August 23rd. If they would like an event t-shirt, they MUST register. T-shirts may not be available the day of the walk. Only those who register and pay the registration fee ON or BEFORE August 23rd will be guaranteed a t-shirt.

SOMEONE DONATED TO MY TEAM, BUT MEANT TO REGISTER FOR THE WALK. WHAT SHOULD THEY DO?

Everyone must complete the registration process online. If a donation was made and now someone can attend the walk, we will require them to complete the registration process online and pay the \$15 registration fee to receive a t-shirt. Although all donations are very generous, donors will NOT receive an event t-shirt unless they register for the event. Contact Michelle at 618-526-3989 or michelled@commlink.org to convert any donations to registrations.

IF I AM REGISTERED, DO I NEED TO DO ANYTHING ELSE TO BE PRE-REGISTERED?

No, if you have already registered online, you are all set.

IS IT BETTER TO REGISTER ONLINE OR REGISTER THE MORNING OF THE WALK?

Pre-registering online is best! You will save \$5 per registration if you register by July 5th. Also, it helps us plan for a better event if we know how many people will be attending. Community Link, event sponsors and vendors order items based on how many people we have pre-registered for the walk. Plus, registering before the walk will alleviate registration lines at the event and you will be able to enjoy the event from the moment you get there. Each individual and team that registers will receive a webpage within the Community Link Buddy Walk® website. This will give friends and family a place to go to donate directly to you online. You can also customize this page with a photo and special message.
